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PREFACE

Cape York Natural Resource Management Ltd. (Cape York NRM)

Cape York NRM is the member owned Regional Natural Resource Management (NRM) body for the Cape York NRM Region.

Cape York NRM supports individuals, groups and communities involved in cultural and natural resource management with funding, professional and practical support, regional coordination and planning, communications and representation.

The Charter given to it by the Cape York community is to fill the role of a regional natural resource management body for the Cape York region including:

- the protection and enhancement of the natural environment;
- to support and facilitate the ecological sustainability and viability of industry to improve quality of life for the community;
- the provision of information and education, building community capacity, the carrying on of research about the natural environment and its management;
- to develop a natural resource management plan and investment strategy for the Cape York region;
- to develop funding applications for the regional and competitive funding programs;
- to be accountable for Australian and State Government funding to implement the natural resource management plan and investment strategy for the Cape York region;
- to, wherever possible, broker partnerships with existing groups, organisations and local governments across Cape York to deliver natural resource management activities.

The organisation's mission is to help people to work together to care for the natural environment and to promote the sustainable use of Cape York's natural resources.


Cape York NRM Board of Directors

Cape York NRM is led by a community based Board of up to 10 from six Sectors:

- Indigenous Sector 5 members
- Local Government Sector 1 member
- Primary Industry Sector 1 member
- Tourism, Small Business, Mining and other Industry Sector 1 member
- Community Sector 1 member
- Conservation Sector 1 member

The Board positions which are currently open for nomination are Directors for the:

- Local Government Sector
- Primary Industry Sector
- Tourism, Small Business, Mining and other Industry Sector
- Community Sector
- Indigenous Zone 1 Sector
- Indigenous Zone 3 Sector.



ELECTION AND VOTING PROCESS

- 1. Election Notices have been distributed calling for nominations for Directors.
- 2. An Independent Returning Officer has been appointed to oversee nominations and voting.
- 3. This Information Package detailing Sector Director Selection Criteria has been made available from Cape York NRM.
- 4. Nominations can be made by completing the enclosed Nomination Form and returning it to Cape York NRM with your Resume. The nomination form contains information on how to submit your nomination. All nominees will receive confirmation that their nomination has been received.
- 5. Director nominations must be received at Cape York NRM by close of business (COB) **21** August 2019.
- 6. The Independent Returning Officer will collate nominations and where there is more than one nomination for a sector, members of that sector will be invited to vote by postal ballot. Directors are appointed by the members of their relevant sector.
- 7. The names of all nominees received prior to the closing date will be listed on the Cape York NRM website.
- 8. As required, ballot papers will be posted to registered members of the membership sector for which there will be a secret postal ballot. Votes will need to be **received at** Cape York NRM by close of business (COB) **8 October 2019**.
- 9. Late votes will NOT BE included in the poll.
- 10. The Independent Returning Officer will count the votes. In the case of a tied vote, the successful nominee will be determined by ballot.
- 11. All nominees will be advised of the outcome of the process by 11 October 2019.
- 12. The newly appointed Directors will be required to attend the meeting of the Board of Directors at Cooktown on 29 November 2019.
- 13. All successful nominees will be required to attend the Cape York NRM Annual General Meeting (AGM) in Cooktown on 30 November 2019 where their appointment will be declared.

GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION

Duties/Responsibilities of a Cape York NRM Director

- A willingness to contribute and make a positive difference for the Company and the natural resource management community.
- Appropriate preparation and active participation in Board and Committee meetings.
- Attendance at the AGM and four Board meetings per year, with a majority being in-person attendance.
- Active participation on at least one Sub-Committee, if required.
- Volunteer for and complete various individual company governance tasks.
- Work well as part of a team.
- Contribute opinion, feedback and decisions regarding matters discussed by the Board.
- Operate in an environment that defines the role of the Board as being focused on setting policy, governing the Company and maintaining a strategic focus.
- Work with a diverse membership base and understand local and regional issues.

Time Commitment

The time commitment includes attendance at meetings of the Board held during the year, plus active participation, if required, on at least one of the Company's Sub-Committees, preparing for and attending Board and Committee meetings (teleconferencing facilities may be available), volunteering and completing various individual Company tasks, and willingness to contribute and make a positive difference. Administrative support is provided by the Cape York NRM Executive Support Officer.

Remuneration

Directors are paid a Board Meeting attendance fee (currently \$350 per day). There are a minimum of 4 Board Meetings per year. Meeting related travel, accommodation and meal expenses are reimbursed at cost.

With Chairman approval, participation in additional meetings, workshops and events or approved work on behalf of Cape York NRM in their official capacity as Directors is currently \$250.00 per day and the fee to be paid to a Director who loses income on days spent travelling to attend formal Board Meetings is currently \$200.00 per day.

The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson positions are remunerated at an annual rate, paid fortnightly (as a stipend). Current remuneration levels are \$30k p.a. (Chairperson) and \$7k p.a. (Vice Chairperson). This remuneration may be taken in cash, goods, services or other entitlements, or a mix of these, up to the value of the Board approved level of remuneration.

Term of Directorship

Directors are appointed for three year terms. A staggered system is in place where one third of Directors retire each year.

Chair and Deputy Chair of the Board

The Chair and Vice-Chair of Cape York NRM Board are selected by the Directors from amongst their number at the first meeting of the Directors after 11 October each year.
